DATE OF HIS BIRTH

The famous Egyptian astronomer, Maḥmūd Pāshā Falkī has written a treatise on the Prophet's date of birth. He has proved after much mathematical calculation that the Prophet graced this world on 9th Rabī al-Awwal (Monday), 20th April, 571 C.E.¹ This orphan was named Muhammad, by grandfather 'Abd al-Muttalib as generally reported.

PERIOD OF LACTATION

Thuwaiba

First of all the holy babe was suckled by the mother, and two or three days later by Thuwaiba, a slave girl of Abū Lahab, the uncle of the Holy Prophet.²

Halima al-Sa'diya

After Thuwaiba he was given suck by Halīma al-Sa'dīya. It was customary in those days that the children of rich and noble houses were sent out to the country-side to be nursed in a free atmosphere. This was done to let

^{1.} The argument of Falkī Pāshā is a lengthy discussion covering many pages. Its gist is given hereunder:

⁽a) In the Sahih of al-Bukhārī it is mentioned that when Ibrāhīm, an infant son of the Prophet died, there was a solar eclipse and the year was 10th Hijra (the Prophet was then in the sixty-third year of life).

⁽b) Mathematical calculation show that the solar eclipse of the 10 Hijra, took place on 7th Jan. 623, C.E. at 8-30 am.

⁽c) These calculations also show that the first of Rabi' al-Awwal fell on 12th April, 571 CE., which would be sixty-three lunar years back.

⁽d) While evidence is not unanimous regarding the specific date of birth, it is agreed on all hands that it was Monday in the month of Rabi' al-Awwal, occurring between 8th and 12th of the month.
