Cambridge: Cambridge University Press, 2019. 304 pp. "Proposes a new model for Muslim historical writing that draws on late antique historiography to challenge the imposition of modern notions of history on a pre-modern society. (...) Discusses three key case studies - the revolt of Mukhtâr b. Abî 'Ubayd (d. 67/687), the life of the Twelver Shî'î Imam Mūsâ 'l-Kâzım (d. 183/799) and the rebellion and subsequent death of the Zaydî Shî'î Imam Yahyâ b. 'Abd Allâh (d. 187/803) - in calling for a new line of inquiry which focuses on larger historiographical questions."
